## Day by Day Itinerary

**Tues., June 19 – CHICAGO/EN ROUTE (I)**  
We depart Chicago by scheduled airline service as we begin the transatlantic journey en route to Munich, Germany.

**Wed., June 20 – MUNICH/ROTHENBURG (I,D)**  
As the sun begins to rise on the German heartland we arrive in Munich where we'll meet our Tour Escort who will accompany us on tour. Leaving Munich Airport we'll travel along the Romantic Road that runs for 350 kilometers across a rich and varied cultural landscape from the Alps to the Franconian wine country and beyond. Along the way, we'll pass small historic towns that have lost nothing of their original charm as we make our way to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, the "Jewel in the Crown" of the Romantic Road. Known for its medieval setting, Rothenburg has been left largely untouched for hundreds of years.

**Thurs., June 21 – ROTHENBURG (B)**  
Our day will begin with a walking tour of Rothenburg, considered to be one of the loveliest and well-preserved walled cities in the entire world. Cameras are a must, as you will feel like we have walked back into the 16th century when we stroll along the cobblestone streets to see the fabled Town Hall and the Plonlein, a picturesque corner formed by the juncture of two streets, before ending with a unique view of the Tauber Valley. Following our tour, the afternoon is free to explore Rothenburg at your leisure. Be sure to visit Kathe Wohlfahrt's world-famous Christmas Store, the German Christmas Museum and peek inside the Museum of Medieval Justice, home to the instruments of torture, punishment and execution of a bygone era.

**Fri., June 22 – ROTHENBURG/SALZBURG (Regensburg) (B,D)**  
Today we depart Rothenburg and travel to the picturesque town of Regensburg. Having escaped major damage during World War II, Regensburg is one of Europe's best-preserved medieval cities and the oldest city along the Danube; its history dates back to its founding by Marcus Aurelius, more than 2,000 years ago. Among its many architectural highlights, we'll see the picturesque stone Steinere Brucke spanning the Danube River, the 15th century Altes Rathaus, and the towering brick structure of St. Peter's Cathedral. Following our visit, we'll be on our way to historic Salzburg, Austria, an enchanting city built on the banks of the Salzach River. As we'll soon see, the city's charm is apparent in its picturesque streets full of wrought-iron signs, noble architecture and highly decorated fountains.

**Sat., June 23 – SALZBURG (B)**  
This morning we will enjoy a tour of Salzburg that will begin on the right bank of the Salzach River where we'll see the grounds of Mirabell Palace and the Mozart Conservatoire before crossing into the Old Town. Here we'll see the 15th century Altes Rathaus and take in the sites along the romantic Getreidgasse, home to Mozart's birthplace, now a museum with many of his early manuscripts and instruments. Next, we'll visit both the Collegiate Church and the Franciscan Church as we make our way to the Residence Square, home to the medieval bishops' residence. Our tour will come to an end following a visit to Salzburg Cathedral and 12th century Benedictine St. Peter's Abbey, seen frequently in the "Sound of Music". Following our tour, the remainder of the day is free to explore Salzburg on your own. The Old Town, on the south bank of the river, is where you'll find the city's most interesting sights. Be

sure to explore the fascinating shops on the quaint Getreidegasse, visit Mozart's birthplace and the 11th century Hohensalzburg stronghold that looms high above the city.

**Sun., June 24 – SALZBURG/SEEFELD (Berchtesgaden & Rattenberg) (B,D)**  
Today we depart Salzburg and travel to the towering Alpine foothills of picturesque Berchtesgaden, Germany, where we'll see the historical town center that boasts decorated facades, churches and a Royal Palace. Then we'll continue to nearby Obersalzburg to board a postal bus for the breathtaking journey up the Kehlstein road, followed by a luxurious brass elevator ride up through the rock into Kehlsteinhaus, Eagle's Nest as named by the Allied Forces. The site combines a unique example of historic architecture and on a clear day there is a magnificent view of the surrounding Alps and a spectacular view of the lovely Konigssee. Next, we'll travel to Rattenberg, Austria, a beautiful town with a captivating medieval atmosphere, located on the banks of the Inn River. This ancient village, nearly 1,000 years old, is alive with beautiful homes and a charming marketplace. However, Rattenberg may be best known for its exquisite crystal and glass, and we'll visit world-famous Kisslinger Crystal to learn of their time-honored tradition. Our day will come to an end as we arrive in the Alpine resort of Seefeld, located on a sunny plateau above the Inn Valley and surrounded by the splendor of the Karwendel and Wetterstein mountain ranges.

**Mon., June 25 – SEEFELD (Linderhof Palace & Oberammergau) (B)**  
A leisurely day on tour will take us to the forests, meadows and peat bogs whose gentle undulations characterize the final slopes of the Ammergau Alps. Our first stop of the day will be Linderhof Palace, perhaps the most interesting of the castles built towards the end of the 19th century by "Mad" King Ludwig II of Bavaria. Parterres, terraces and magnificent fountains embellish the park, and the palace itself is sumptuously decorated in an intriguing mixture of Italian Renaissance and Baroque styles. Next, we'll stop to visit the village of Oberammergau, known not only for its Passion Play, but also for its wood carvings and the Luftmalerei, the paintings that decorate many of the walls of the old houses. Free time will be set aside to wander Oberammergau's quaint downtown, an opportunity to visit the baroque Parish Church, and to see the beautifully painted homes, many in fairytale design depicting scenes from Little Red Riding Hood and Hansel and Gretel.

**Tues., June 26 – SEEFELD (B)**  
The day is free to explore the villages of the Seefeld plateau - Seefeld, Leutasch, Mosern, Scharnitz and Reith bei Seefeld. Few resorts can match the regions unique combination of traditional charm and modern amenities. Browse the delightful shops in search of that perfect gift, relax with quiet meadow and mountain walk, horse-drawn carriage ride, or even a chair lift and cable car journey into the surrounding Alps to enjoy one of Austria's most beautiful mountain views.

**Wed., June 27 – SEEFELD (Innsbruck & Vipiteno) (B,D)**  
Today we will enjoy one of the most spectacular rail journeys in the Tyrol when we travel from Seefeld to Innsbruck, the capital of the Austrian Tyrol. On arrival, we'll enjoy a walking tour of Innsbruck's Old Town and take in the 15th and 16th century houses, Town Hall and Belfry, and the Goldenes Dachl, a charming structure built by Friedrich the Penniless to end jokes about his poverty. Then

we'll board our waiting motor coach for a journey over the scenic Brenner Pass and across the Italian border to the region known as the Sudtyrol. Here we'll visit the historic town of Vipiteno that charms visitors with a picturesque main street of Tyrolean houses with arcades, oriel windows and wrought iron signs welcoming shoppers in search of bargains.

**Thurs., June 28 – SEEFELD/CHICAGO (B,I)**

Early this morning we depart Seefeld and leave behind the vistas of the Bavarian Alps as we travel to Munich Airport in preparation for our return journey home. No better time to celebrate a beginning of new friendships and reflect on memories to last a lifetime!

**TOUR DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT:** Payment is accepted by personal or bank checks. **YOU WILL BE INVOICED FOR THE BALANCE OF PAYMENT DUE ON OR BEFORE FRIDAY, MARCH 23, 2012.**

**ARRANGEMENTS:** The tour price is based on a minimum participation of 25 persons and includes planning, handling and operational charges and is quoted on the current rate of exchange, tariff rates and airfares in effect as of January 1, 2012. In the event of a marked increase or decrease in foreign currency or in tariff rates, the cost is subject to revision.

**TOUR PRICING:** This is a package tour in which land tour costs and special group airfares have been combined in the most advantageous way. Should you wish to take the land tour only or deviate from the package tour by changing your departure and/or return dates of travel, this will eliminate the advantages of the package tour price and special group airfares. There will be a service charge of \$100 per person for altering the airline itinerary, plus any additional charges assessed by the airlines.

**TRIP CANCELLATION, BAGGAGE AND MEDICAL INSURANCE:** You have been given the option of purchasing trip cancellation, baggage and medical insurance **at the time you sign-up for the tour.** The insurance program does not cover cancellation for non-medical reasons. The insurance includes: Trip Cancellation Insurance up to the full price of the tour cost; Trip Interruption up to 150% of the tour cost; Travel Delay - \$750; Baggage - \$1,500; Baggage Delay - \$250; Medical Expense - \$25,000; Emergency Medical Transportation - \$250,000; Accidental Death and Dismemberment - \$25,000. **The insurance premium is non-refundable if you cancel from the tour, and is based on a minimum participation of 10 travelers.**

**CANCELLATION:** If after making your initial deposit you find it necessary to cancel from the tour for any reason, there will be a charge of \$100 per person up to 90 days prior to departure. For cancellation between 89 and 60 days prior to departure, there will be a cancellation charge of \$300 per person. **AIRLINE TICKETING:** For ticketing purposes legal first, middle and last names are required (identical to your passport). Once airline tickets have been issued and if a ticket requires a name change because of incorrect information supplied to our office, the client is responsible for any applicable airline charges.
